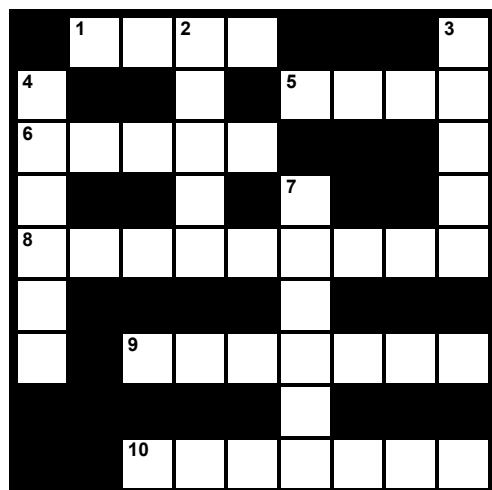

## Across

- 1 A musical notation indicating one half step lower than the note named. (4)
- 5 A nihilistic art movement (especially in painting) that flourished in Europe early in the 20th century; based on irrationality and negation of the accepted laws of beauty. (4)
- 6 Any of a class of solid or semisolid viscous substances obtained either as exudations from certain plants or

prepared by polymerization of simple molecules. (5)

- 8 Art created by artists veering away from the traditional concepts and techniques of painting or sculpture. (6,3)
- 9 Dry coloring matter (especially an insoluble powder to be mixed with a liquid to produce paint etc). (7)
- 10 A thin varnish made by dissolving lac in ethanol; used to finish wood. (7)

- 2 Any organic compound containing the group -CONH2. (5)
- 3 A substance used as a coating to protect or decorate a surface (especially a mixture of pigment suspended in a liquid); dries to form a hard coating. (5)
- 4 The first or preliminary coat of paint or size applied to a surface. (6)
- 7 Any smooth glossy coating that resembles ceramic glaze.
