

- 2 A device which makes aquarium water cooler. (7)
- 4 A measure of how acidic or alkaline a solution is. (2)
- 7 Fairy shrimp; brine shrimp. (7)
- 8 A device that removes something from whatever passes through it. (6)
- 9 A device to warm the aquarium water. (6)
- 11 Chemicals, just like vitamins, needed to be replenished in small amounts for

aquarium creatures to survive. (5,8)

- 13 Added to water in the form of chloride (SrCl_2) and is necessary for the growth of calcareous skeletons. (9)
- 14 Acronym for reduction-oxidation potential. (5)

- 1 Fish which produce live young rather than laying eggs. (4,7)

- 4 This is a small mechanical filter attached to the input to another filter to avoid clogging in the latter. (9)
- 5 German word for water with calcium hydroxide dissolved in it. (10)

- 6 Partially carbonized vegetable matter saturated with water; can be used as a filter material to soften water and make it more acidic. (4)

- 12 A receptacle that is placed under the main aquarium, to increase the system's total water volume, and to place various pieces of hardware, like pumps, heaters, reactors, probes, etc. (4)
