

- 2 CATCC = Carrier Air XXXXXXXX Control Center. (7)
- 5 Left side of ship. (4)
- 6 On a lower deck. (5)
- 7 Any of various floor-like platforms built into a vessel. (4)
- 10 A front that resembles a human nose (especially the front of an aircraft). (4)
- 11 The stern area of the main deck, e.g. the hangar deck on a carrier. (7)

Down

- 1 Modular pieces constructed independently are then assembled into the steel body of the ship to form the whole carrier. (9)
- 2 Armament consisting of a long cylindrical self-propelled underwater projectile that detonates on contact with a target. (7)
- 3 While landing on carrier's deck, the pilot pushes the airplanes engines to XXXX power. (4)

- 4 The men who man a ship or aircraft. (4)
- 8 A unit of length used in navigation; equivalent to the distance spanned by one minute of arc in latitude; 1,852 meters. (4)
- 9 One of the main longitudinal beams (or plates) of the hull of a vessel. (4)
