- 13 A grasping structure on the limb of a crustacean or other arthropods. (4)

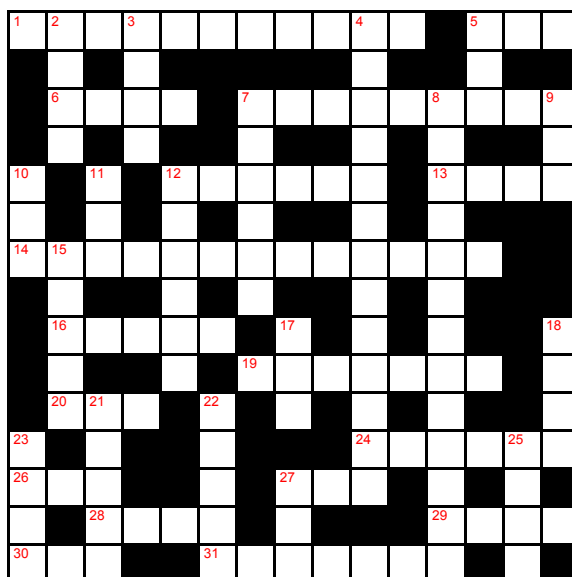
- 14 Black-and-white shorebird with stout legs and bill; feed on oysters etc. (13)

- 19 Nocturnal gregarious pig-like wild animals of North America and South America; a.k.a. musk hog. (7)
- 20 Large African antelope having a head with horns like an ox and a long tufted tail; a.k.a. wildebeest. (3)

- 24 Any of various burrowing animals of the family Leporidae having long ears and short tails; some domesticated and raised for pets or food. (6)
- 26 The sense organ for hearing and equilibrium. (3)
- 27 Major food fish of arctic and cold-temperate waters. (3)

- 28 A small rodent similar to a mouse but with a shorter tail and legs and a stocky body. (4)
- 29 A large flightless bird that looks like an ostrich but is slightly smaller. (4)
- 30 The organ of sight. (3)
- 31 Large feline of African and Asian forests usually having a tawny coat with black spots. (7)
