

- 1 The only non-human creature that suffers from sunburn. (3)
- 3 A clawed foot of an animal especially a quadruped. (3)
- 5 The free-swimming reproductive stage of an animal such as a jellyfish, during which it has a transparent umbrella-shaped body with tentacles. (6)
- 8 Any of various primates with short tails or no tail at all. (3)
- 9 Small terrestrial or aquatic crustaceans with seven pairs of legs adapted for crawling. (6)
- 11 Baboon of west Africa with a bright red and blue muzzle and blue hindquarters. (8)
- 12 A group of leopards. (4)

- 14 A person or animal whose skin and hair lack pigmentation and whose irises are pink because of a hereditary condition albinism. (6)
- 15 Voracious snakelike marine or freshwater fishes with smooth slimy usually scaleless skin and having a continuous vertical fin but no ventral fins. (3)
- 16 A small short-tailed rodent that has fur-lined cheek pouches and short legs and digs sizable burrows. (6)
- 20 Any of numerous extinct terrestrial reptiles of the Mesozoic era. (8)
- 22 Whisker on animal's head. (4)
- 23 Skeletal axis protecting spinal cord. (5)
- 24 Small European brown bat. (11)

- 25 Large Australian flightless bird similar to the ostrich but smaller. (3)
- 26 Hard bonelike structure in the jaws of vertebrates. (5)

- 1 Toothless mammal of southern Africa and Asia having a body covered with horny scales and a long snout for feeding on ants and termites. (8)
- 2 Stout-bodied nearly tailless domesticated cavy; often kept as a pet and widely used in research (6-3)
- 4 Any of many long-legged birds that wade in water in search of food. (6,4)
- 5 A pliable sheet of tissue that covers or lines or connects organs or cells of animals; a.k.a. tissue layer. (8)
- 6 Having or resembling hoofs. (8)
- 7 Black-and-white short-necked web-footed diving bird of northern seas. (3)
- 10 The vast grassy plains of northern Argentina. (6,7)
- 13 World's largest polar animal. (5,4)
- 17 Similar to the giraffe but smaller with much shorter neck and stripe on the legs. (5)
- 18 Web-footed long-necked typically gregarious migratory aquatic bird. (5)
- 19 Extensive plain without trees like the one in Siberia. (6)
- 21 A shed containing a number of beehives. (6)
