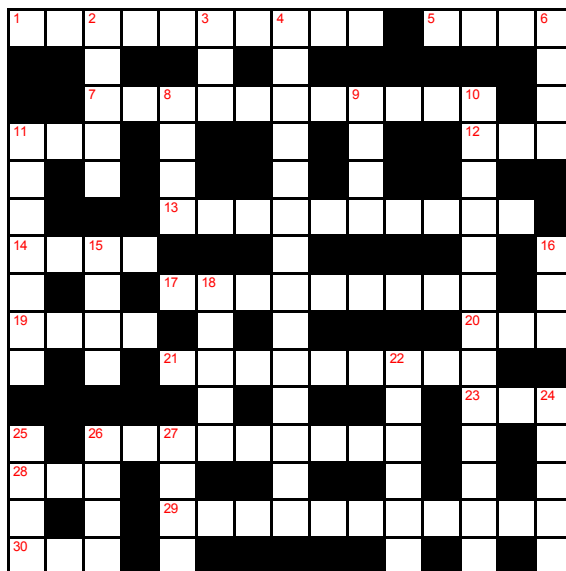
- 1 Any of various tropical American bats that bite mammals and birds to feed on their blood. (7,3)

- 7 Small fish having rows of luminous organs along each side; some surface at night. (7,4)
- 11 Any of several chiefly tropical constrictors with vestigial hind limbs. (3)
- 12 Nocturnal bird of prey with hawk-like beak and claws and large head with front-facing eyes. (3)

- 13 Horse adapted for drawing heavy loads. (5,5)

- 17 Large web-footed birds of the southern hemisphere having long narrow wings; noted for powerful gliding flight. (9)
