

- 1 E' in 'EDID', a communications protocol developed by VESA for the identification of display devices to computers using the DDC (Display Data Channel) transmission standard. (8)
- 6 A test pattern that assists in properly setting picture black level. (5)
- 7 In audio, a sequence of puretone frequencies used to generate a frequency response curve. (5)
- 9 Two or more devices communicating with each other and sharing resources. (10)
- 10 An antenna technology, that promises to deliver up to 8x coverage and up to 6x speed of current

802.11g networks. (4)
