

- 1 The boundary of a surface (4)
- 4 A column of light (as from a beacon). (4)
- 8 Abbreviation for the international base unit of electrical current that represents the rate flow of electric charges through a conductor. (3)
- 9 An Extron technology for scan converters and signal processors that simplifies setup by executing image sizing, centering, and filtering adjustments with a single button push. (9)
- 10 Colour \_\_\_\_: A device that combines the separate red, green, and blue signals into one composite video signal. (7)
- 12 An absolute scale of temperature measurement used to describe the colour of light, expressed in "degrees \_\_\_\_". The lower the number, the "warmer" or redder the colour of the light; a higher number indicates a "colder", or bluer light

- 13 \_\_\_\_ effect: A distorted picture where length of one edge is not the same as the opposite edge, producing a tapered or wedge shape. (8)
- 17 \_\_\_\_ graphics: A computer graphics operation that takes place automatically and without operator intervention. (7)
- 18 Amplification of a signal, unit, or system. Expressed in the unit of measurement appropriate to the signal or system. (4)
- 19 Black \_\_\_\_: The video waveform without the video elements. (5)
- 2 Frequency \_\_\_\_: The means of representing a signal as a plot of amplitude (vertical axis) versus frequency (horizontal axis). (6)
- 3 N' in 'ISDN', an international communications standard for sending voice, video, and data digitally over telephone lines. (7)
- 5 Video compression algorithm used for DVD-Video, Digital Broadcast Satellite (DBS), and Digital TV (including HDTV) delivery systems. (4-1)
- 6 A unique hardware number given to devices that connect to the Internet. When your computer or networking device (router, hub, interface, etc.) is connected to the Internet, a table relates the device's IP address to its corresponding physical address on the LAN. (3,7)
- 7 A video problem that shows up as a faint picture for lack of video information. (6,4)
- 10 X' in 'IPX', a protocol commonly used over Novell Netware and Microsoft Windows networks. (8)
- 11 High \_\_\_\_: Accurate, and faithful reproduction of the original. Absence of distortion or enhancements. (8)
- 14 First 'S' in 'S-VHS', a high band video recording process for VHS that increases the picture quality and resolution capability. (5)
- 15 Similar to MPEG-2, but with a much greater ability to scale to different compression rates and resolutions. (4-1)
- 16 A transmission and connectivity standard developed by Sony that is used for digital video connections on the Sony VAIO PCs and laptops. (4)
