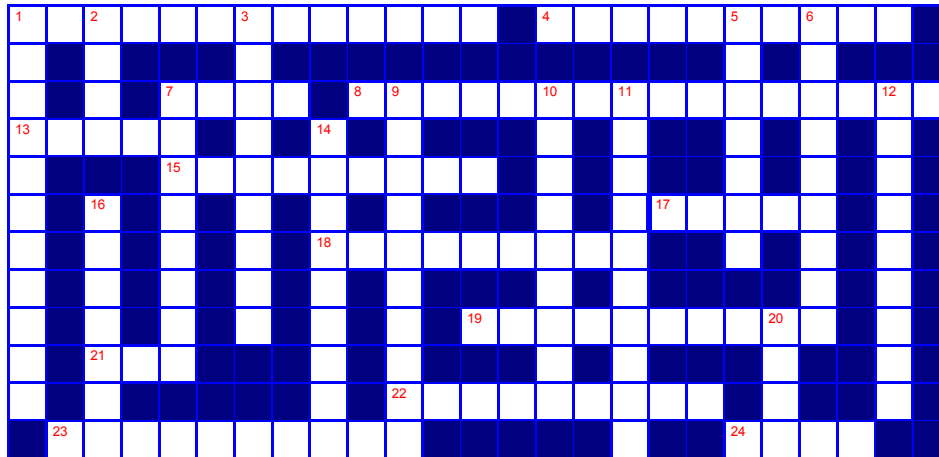

- 7** ____ Reject filter: A filter that is used to block a narrow band of frequencies, while allowing frequencies above or below this band to pass. (4)
- 8** A crossover network that divides audio frequencies without any active amplification or buffering components and which uses only resistors, capacitors and inductors. (7,9)
- 13** A person who owns something. (5)
- 15** 'T' in 'DVI', the digital video connectivity standard that was developed by DDWG. (9)
- 17** Represent by means of a graph. (5)
- 18** An early type of LCD panel technology before polysilicon. (9)
- 19** A metal plate with holes or vertical lines that is used to determine exactly where the electron beam strikes the CRT screen. (6,4)
