

- 13 ____ video - An all-in-one video signal comprised of the luma (black and white), chroma (colour), blanking pulses, sync pulses, and colour burst. (9)
- 14 DC ____: A circuit that passes both AC and DC components of a signal, and therefore is sensitive to DC offsets. (7)
- 18 A transformer used to isolate video signals caused by interference from hum bars or moiré. (9)
