

## **Across**

- 3** Principal sugar found in nectar. (7)
- 6** The egg producing part of a bee. (5)
- 7** Any of two long segmented sensory filaments located on the head of the bee; used for smell and taste. (7)
- 8** A crowd of bees leaving their parent colony to establish a new colony. (5)

- 10** Removal of visible foreign material from honey. (13)
- 12** Science and art of beekeeping. (10)
- 13** Hexagonal compartment of a honey comb. (4)
- 14** A sweet viscid material produced by bees from the nectar of flowers. (5)
- 16** Eight glands of bees that secrete bees wax. (3,6)

## **Down**

- 1** Bees in the stage of eggs, larvae, or pupae, not yet emerged from their cells. (5)
- 2** Formation of dextrose crystals in honey. (11)
- 4** A small sac like organ of the queen (like many other insects) in which the sperm of the drone is stored. (11)
- 5** Wine made of fermented honey and water (4)

- 9** Sap or resinous materials collected from trees or plants by bees and used to strengthen the comb, close-up cracks, etc.; also called bee glue. (8)
- 11** XXXXX honey - thick plastic honey cut from frames. (5)
- 15** First stage of bee metamorphosis. (3)
