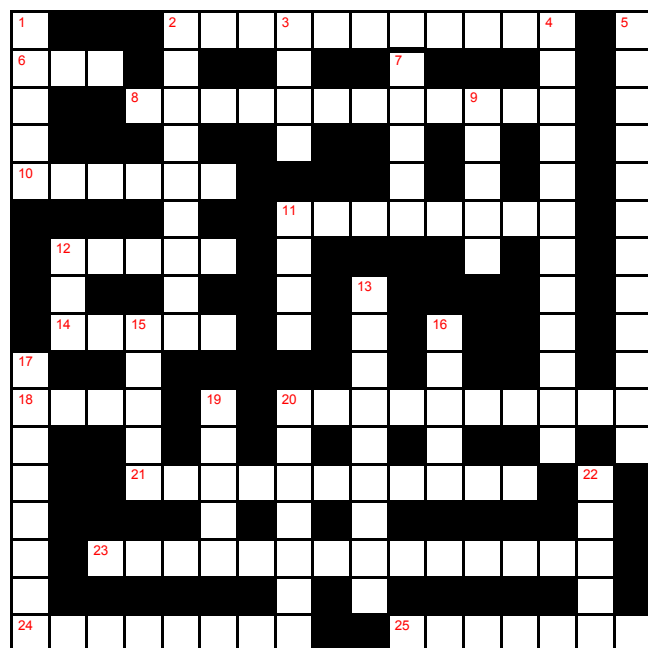

- 6 Nature's digital signature. A nucleic acid that carries the genetic information in the cell and is capable of self-replication and synthesis of RNA (3)
- 8 The branch of medical science dealing with the transmission and control of disease (12)
- 10 It is bigger in diameter and has walls that are stronger and more elastic than the walls of veins. Carries blood from heart to other parts of body (6)
- 11 Clouding of the natural lens of the eye (8)
- 12 Having dire consequence like death (5)
- 14 Noninsulin-dependent diabetes (4,1)
- 18 A small but most vital

component of the haemoglobin (4)

- 20 Proteins that the body makes to protect itself from foreign substances (10)
