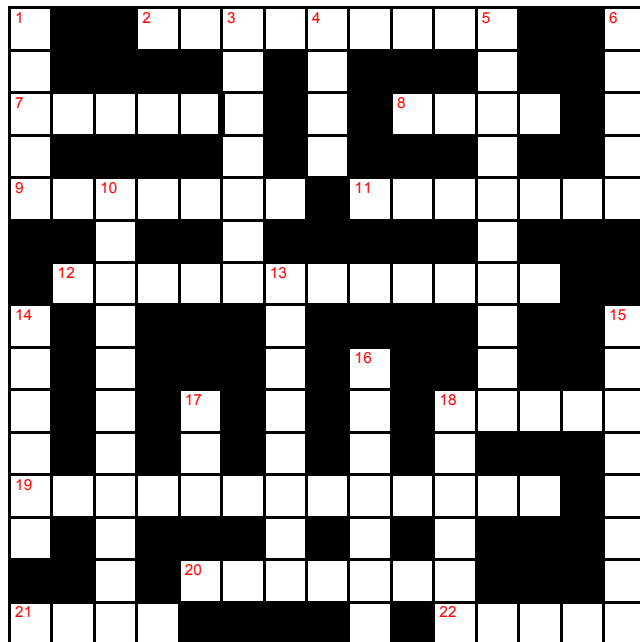

- 2 Bleeding from the nose; also called epistaxis. (9)
- 7 Urge or force (a person) to an action. (5)
- 8 A soft disposable cloth or tissue soaked with a cleansing liquid, used for cleaning something such as the skin. (4)
- 9 An acute and serious infection of the central nervous system caused by bacterial infection of open wounds. (7)
- 11 CNS stands for \_\_\_\_\_ Nervous System. (7)
- 12 Burns affect the skin's lower layers as well as the outer skin. They are painful, swollen, and show redness and blisters. (6,6)
- 18 Bleached cotton cloth of plain weave used for bandages and dressings. (5)
- 19 Trauma caused by the passage of electric

current through the body. (8,5)

- 20 A condition promoting sanitary practices. (7)
- 21 An injury cause by exposure to heat or chemicals or radiation (4)
- 22 to puncture or tear the skin of a person or animal using fangs, teeth, or mouthparts (5)

- 1 Pass out from weakness, physical or emotional distress due to a loss of blood supply to the brain. (5)
- 3 Redness of the skin caused by exposure to the rays of the sun. (7)
- 4 A wound resulting from biting by an animal or a person (4)
- 5 Formation of a false membrane in the throat and other air passages

causing difficulty in breathing. (10)

- 6 Infections like measles, mumps, rubella, hepatitis, influenza, chickenpox, HIV and the common cold. (5)
- 10 Instrument for measuring body temperature. (11)
- 13 A cloth covering for a wound or sore. (8)
- 14 An acute viral disease of the nervous system of warm-blooded animals (usually transmitted by the bite of a rabid animal); rabies is fatal if the virus reaches the brain (6)
- 15 Relating to breathing with a whistling sound. (8)
- 16 An elevation of the skin filled with serous fluid. (7)
- 17 Split in the skin caused by a sharp object, such as a knife, or even a dull object. (3)
