

- 1 A lineage or race. (5)
- 3 A young domestic cock; not older than one year. (8)
- 6 The median ridge on the breastbone of birds that fly. (4)
- 7 Male turkey. (3)
- 8 The horny protuberance at the juncture of the head and upper bill in African and Chinese Geese. (4)
- 10 Adult male of a wild or domestic duck. (5)

- 12 The skin around and below the eyes on either side of the head of a fowl. (4)
- 14 The portion of the leg below the hock, exclusive of the foot and toes. (5)
- 15 Short feather growing between primaries and secondaries of the wing. (5,7)
- 16 Globular tuft of feathers on the top of the head of some fowl and waterfowl. (5)

- 1 The top section of the body from the base of the neck to the base of the tail. (4)
- 2 The light horny waterproof structure forming the external covering of birds. (7)
- 3 Adult male chicken. (4)
- 4 Castrated male chicken. (5)
- 5 A cluster of feathers hanging from the upper throat of some fowl. (5)
- 9 A tightly folded; slim, tapering, whip-like tail. (4,4)
- 11 Cover feathers growing on the underside of the wing of waterfowl. (7)
- 12 The light horny waterproof structure forming the external covering of birds, (7)
- 13 The colored circle that surrounds the black pupil. (4)
- 14 The hollow stem of a feather. (5)
