

Across

- 1 Top of the sail. (4)
- 2 A linear unit of measurement (equal to 6 feet) for water depth. (6)
- 6 A line used for extending or fastening rigging on ships. (7)
- 7 The gradual departure of boat from an intended course due to external influences. (5)
- 8 Steering mechanism for a vessel; a mechanical device by which a vessel is steered. (4)
- 9 The side of something that is sheltered from the wind. (3)
- 10 To move or cause to move in a

specified way, direction, or position. (5)

- 12 Where the sides of the vessel curve in to form the bottom. (5)

- 13 A sailboat with a single mast set far forward. (7)

- 16 A line that holds an object (especially a boat) in place. (7)

- 19 A buoy with a round bottom and conical top. (3)

- 20 With the bottom lodged on the ground. (7)

- 21 Sailing close to the wind. (4)

- 22 The heading or position of a vessel relative to the trim of its sails. (4)

- 23 Shift from one side of the ship to the other. (4)

Down

- 1 The frame or body of ship. (4)

- 3 A line (rope or chain) that regulates the angle at which a sail is set in relation to the wind. (9)

- 4 Remove (water) from a vessel with a container. (4)

- 5 A boat for communication between ship and shore. (6)

- 7 The weight of the water displaced by the boat. (12)

- 8 The person who steers a ship. (8)

- 9 Lean over to one side; used frequently of ships. (4)

- 11 Formation of masts, spars, sails, etc., on a vessel. (7)

- 12 Front part of a vessel. (3)

- 14 A long-handled oar mounted at the stern of a boat and moved left and right to propel the boat forward. (5)

- 15 A guide for an anchor, mooring or docking line, attached to the deck. (5)

- 17 The path taken by a ship or plane that maintains a constant compass direction. (5)

- 18 A buoy resembling a cone. (3)

- 20 Situated at or toward the stern or tail. (3)
