

Across

- 1 Feathers that smoothen the flight of the arrow. (9)
- 4 A piece of leather that protects the fingers from string wear. (6,3)
- 6 Straw disk behind the target face. (4)
- 8 Driving the tip of an arrow into the end of another arrow that's already in the target. (5,4)

Down

- 10 An arrow with over-sized feathers, used in bird hunting. (3-3)
- 11 The end loop of a bow string. (3)
- 12 A group of arrows before being retrieved from the target and scored. (3)
- 13 A certain number of arrows, shot from established distances, in competition. A round is made up of ends. (5)
- 2 Slight forward movement of the arrow point before release. (8)
- 3 Part of the bow from the handle to the tip. (4)
- 4 As per INternational Archery Foundation Rules, a round of 144 arrows, with 36 shot each from four distances. (4,5)
- 5 A sharpened steel point used in bow hunting. (9)
- 7 To release. (5)

- 9 The side of the bow nearest the archer. (5)
