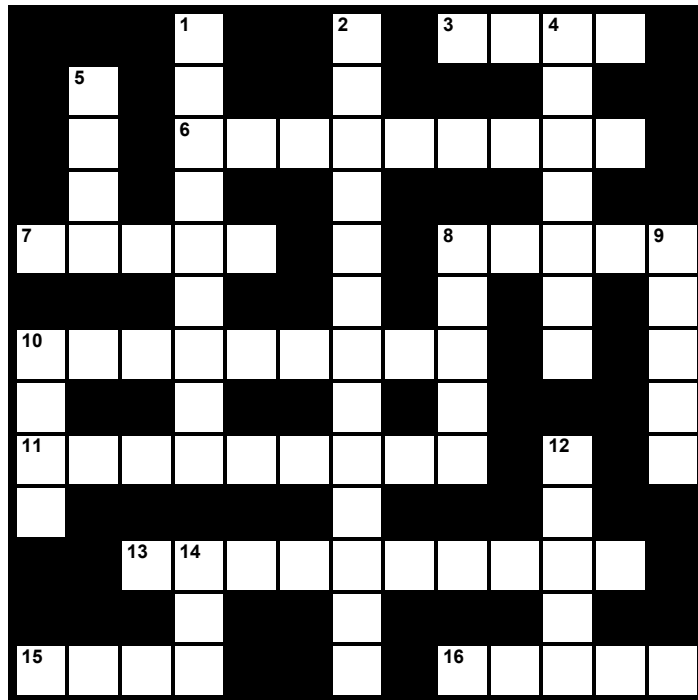

- 3 A burst of speed near the finish line. (4)
- 6 Also called granny gear. (5,4)
- 7 To slow down suddenly in the pace line with the intention to prevent the chaser to overtake. (5)
- 8 The main group of riders in a race. (5)

- 10 An attack by a rider or group of riders that leaves the main group behind. (5-4)
- 11 A direct drive system in which pedals turn constantly while the bicycle is moving and coasting is not possible. (5,4)
- 13 The area of lowered wind resistance behind a rider. (10)
- 15 A sudden sprint. (4)
- 16 A metal or plastic projection

on the sole of the cycling shoe to prevent slipping. (5)

- 1 Here the losers of previous races are made to compete with each other and their winners are allowed entry to main racing event. (9)
- 2 A multi-coloured striped jersey awarded to world champions. (7,6)

- 4 Riders involved in a chase. (7)
- 5 To take a turn at the front of the group, maintaining the same speed as of the group. (4)
- 8 Surprise attack by a rider. (5)
- 9 To ride closely behind another racer for reduced resistance. (5)
- 10 A crash. (4)
- 12 Engaged in breakaway. (5)
- 14 Movement once around a course. (3)
