

Across

- 1 A card signifying the referee has warned a player about an infraction. (6,4)
- 5 When a player is sent out from the game with no replacement allowed. (9)
- 6 Also called a "seven-metre throw". (7,5)
- 7 Any player on the court except a goalkeeper; also known as a "court player". (5,6)
- 9 A player centred largely around

midcourt who directs the offence and tries to penetrate the defence; also called a "centre back". (9)

- 10 Fresh start awarded for a minor offence by the opponent. (4,5)

12 A player, usually tall and a good jumper, who shoots from the backcourt. (7)

- 13 A throw from the side of the court to restart play after the ball has gone over the sidelines.

(5-2)

- 14 Similar to a jump ball in basketball, a throw into the air by the referee so a player on each team can jump and try to gain control of the ball. (7,5)

Down

- 2 Also known as a "field player". (5,6)
- 3 The D-shaped area extending six metres from the goal and occupied only by the goalkeeper. (4,4)
- 4 A shot released at the high point of a jump. (4,4)
- 8 A throw from the centre line to a team-mate at least three metres away and behind the line, used to restart play. (5-3)
- 9 An offensive player who plays largely around the six-metre line; also called a "line player". (5)
- 11 A player who plays largely along the side of the court. (4)
