- 8 A shot with lifted puck towards the goal. (4,4)
- 9 A chance for team in control of puck to start the attack when the opposing team is not in good position. (5)
- 12 Rush by a player alone and unassisted by teammates. (4)
- 14 A violation committed when a player's both skates cross the blue line before the puck crosses it. It leads to face-off. (7)
- 16 The iced area on which the game of hockey is played. (4)
- 18 A method of taking the puck out of defensive zone and starting an attack. (8)
- 19 A goal scored in an unguarded net. (5,3,4)
- 21 The chief official of the game. (7)
- 22 A pass without a sight on target. (5,4)
- 24 three 20-minute playing intervals separated by two intermissions. (7)
- 25 The successful attempt by goalie to stop a shot. (4)
- 27 Retaining the puck for long time by clever stick manipulations. (7)
- 29 A major penalty for

- instigator of the fight between two or more players. (8)
- 30 A very high speed shot. (4,4)
- 31 He guards the goal. Also called goalkeeper. (6)

- 2 Disturbing the balance of an opponent by placing his stick or body under the legs of the opponent; attracts minor penalty. (8)
- 3 Attack by a team possessing the puck. (4)
- 4 Horizontal bar connecting the top of the two goalposts. (5,3)

- 6 Pass to a player attempting a breakaway. (8,4)
- 7 Rebound of the puck after hitting the boards or some other object. (5)
- 10 Penalty for hitting the opponent with knee. (7)
- 11 A team with one or more of its players confined to penalty box. (11)
- 13 A player following his attacking teammate ready to receive a pass. (7)
- 15 Any violation of the rules attracting penalty. (4)
- 17 A less severe fight than fighting, attracting minor penalty. (8)

- 18 A minor penalty for hitting the opponent with the butt. (4-6)
- 19 A strong man primarily responsible for protecting his teammates from harm. (8)
- 20 Penalty for hitting the opponent with elbow. (8)
- 23 A pass preceding a successful goal attempt. (6)
- 24 A black rubber disc used to play hockey. (4)
- 26 A shot from behind the red center line, which crosses opponent's goal line after being touched by an opponent other than the goalie. (5)
- 28 The goal. (3)
