

Across

- 2** A ball with a great deal of spin. (6)
- 3** Nine feet long and five feet wide with playing surface at a height of 2 feet, 6 inches above the floor. (5)
- 6** A long sweeping upward motion that just grazes the ball and puts tremendous spin on it. (4)
- 8** A score of 7-0. (5)
- 10** Also called a counterdrive. (3)
- 11** A rubber sheet on the bat having a very low friction coefficient. (8)

Down

- 1** A match or game consisting of individual players competing against each other. (7)
- 2** A serve that strikes the net before falling into the receiver's court; the ball must be served again. (3)
- 4** The bat is held in front of the ball with little movement at the point of contact. (5)
- 5** A ball landing near the net. (5)
- 7** To force the opponent to hit the ball into the net. (4)
- 9** Six inches high strip of netting dividing the table into two equal parts. (3)
