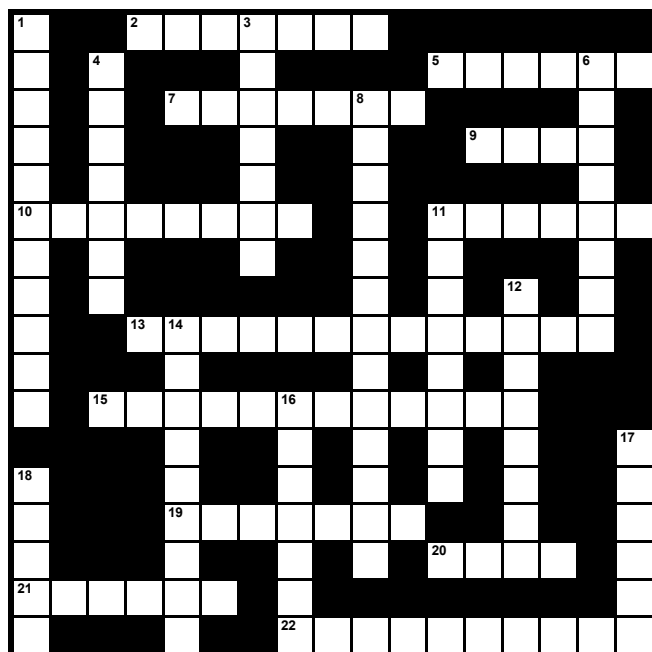

- 2 A martial art sport involving use of swords. (7)
- 5 A game played in an enclosed court by two or four players who strike the ball with long-handled rackets. (6)
- 7 The sport of shooting arrows with a bow. (7)
- 9 A sport adapted from jujitsu (using principles of not resisting) and similar to wrestling; developed in Japan. (4)
- 10 Water sport of travelling in water without mechanical aids.. (8)
- 11 A traditional Japanese system of unarmed combat;

sharp blows and kicks are given to pressure-sensitive points on the body of the opponent. (6)

- 13 Ice skating where the skates trace outlines of selected figures. (6,7)
- 15 Racing on skates. (5,7)
- 19 A game played on ice; curling stones (heavy stones with handles) are slid toward a target (7)
- 20 A racing sled for one or two people. (4)
- 21 A football game in which two teams of 11 players try to kick or head a ball into the opponents' goal. (6)
- 22 A sport that involves exercises intended to display strength and balance and agility.

- 1 Skiing on water while being towed by a motorboat. (5,6)
- 3 The sport of traveling on a bicycle. (7)
- 4 A game in which balls are rolled at an object or group of objects with the aim of knocking them over. (7)
- 6 The sport involving firing of projectiles. (8)
- 8 Skating on wheels. (6,7)
- 11 Racing in small canoe. (8)
- 12 Also called table tennis. (4-4)
- 14 A game played on an ice rink by two

opposing teams of 6 skaters each who try to knock a flat round puck into the opponents' goal with hockey sticks. (3,6)

- 16 Riding in a sail boat. (7)
- 17 A game played with rackets by two or four players who hit a ball back and forth over a net that divides the court. (6)
- 18 A game for two players who move their 16 pieces according to specific rules; the object is to checkmate the opponent's king. (5)
