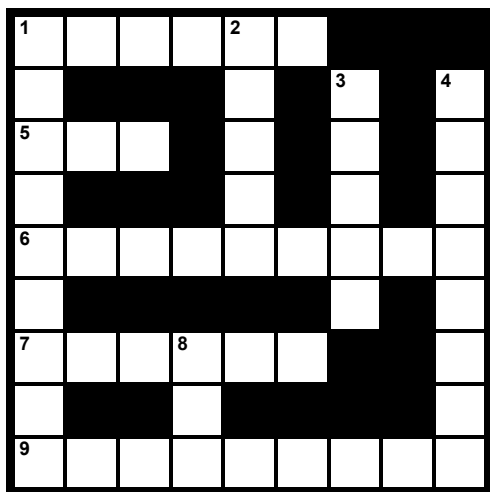

- 1 Any of the small solid extraterrestrial bodies that hits the earth's atmosphere. (6)
- 5 A fluorocarbon with chlorine. (3)
- 6 An area of the ozone layer (near the poles) that is seasonally depleted of ozone. (5,4)
- 7 The ratio of reflected to incident light. (6)
- 9 The outermost atmospheric layer. (9)

Down

- 1 A short electromagnetic wave (longer than infrared but shorter than radio waves). (9)

- 2 A strong oxidizing agent. (5)
- 3 A compound in which the hydrogen atoms of a hydrocarbon have been replaced by bromine and other halogen atoms. (5)
- 4 Any of a class of highly reactive chemical compounds; used in making resins and dyes and organic acids. (8)
- 8 Entire spectrum of electromagnetic radiation ranging from gamma rays, less than 0.03 nanometers, to radio waves, greater than or equal to 30 centimeters. (3)
