

- 1 Low-lying wet land with grassy vegetation; usually is a transition zone between land and water. (5)
- 3 A substance that initiates or accelerates a chemical reaction without itself being affected. (8)
- 6 A waste pipe that carries away sewage or surface water. (5)
- 7 A person who has some pathogen to which he is immune but who can pass it on to others. (7)
- 8 The residue that remains when something is burned. (3)
- 9 All the plant and animal life of a particular region. (5)

- 10 A phenomenon associated with surface tension and resulting in the elevation or depression of liquids in capillaries. (9,6)
- 12 The entire geographical area drained by a river and its tributaries. (5,5)
- 14 The lowest temperature at which the vapor above a liquid can be ignited in air. (5,5)
- 15 Sedimentary materials composed of fine or intermediate-sized mineral particles. (4)
- 17 Applying a pesticide so as to create a foggy envelope. (7)
- 18 An insecticide that is also toxic to animals and humans; banned in the United States since 1972. (3)

- 19 Fine solid particles of ash that are carried into the air when fuel is combusted. (3,3)

- 1 A thin fog with condensation near the ground. (4)
- 2 Device for heating liquids above their boiling point to sterilize surgical instruments. (10)
- 4 Depending on free oxygen or air. (7)
- 5 The process in which one substance takes up or holds another (by either absorption or adsorption). (8)
- 7 Discoloration of normally green plant parts caused by disease, lack of nutrients, or various air pollutants. Also called green sickness. (9)
- 10 A state of deterioration in metals caused by oxidation or chemical action. (9)
- 11 Cloudiness in water due to suspended particles. (9)
- 13 Compacting solid wastes into blocks to facilitate easy handling. (6)
- 16 (Pb) A heavy metal that is hazardous to health when inhaled or swallowed. (4)
