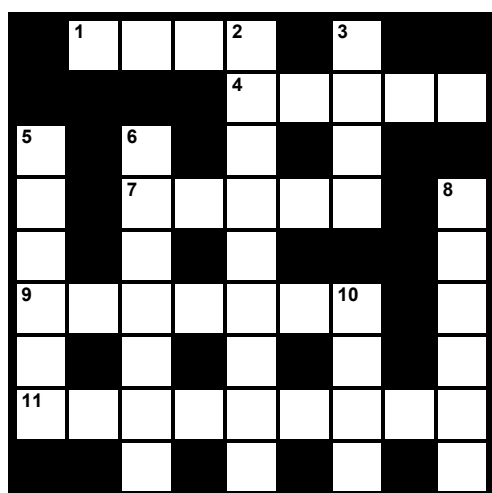


Environment Protection - 9 x 9



Across

1 A small loosely aggregated mass of flocculent material suspended in or precipitated from a liquid. (4)

4 A compound in which the hydrogen atoms of a hydrocarbon have been replaced by bromine and other halogen atoms; very stable; used in fire extinguishers although it is thought to release bromine that depletes the ozone layer. (5)

7 A cloud of fine particles suspended in a gas. (5)

9 Containing or dissolved in water. (7)

11 An animal that feeds on plants. (9)

2 Discoloration of normally green plant parts caused by disease, lack of nutrients, or various air pollutants. Also called green sickness. (9)

3 A conduit to carry off smoke. (4)

5 Fine solid particles of ash that are carried into the air when fuel is combusted. (3,3)

6 The wide part of a river where it nears the sea; fresh and salt water mix. (7)

8 Small scales from animal skins or hair or

bird feathers that can cause allergic reactions in some people. (6)

10 Air pollution by a mixture of smoke and fog. (4)
