

- 1 Feathers that smooth the flight of the arrow. (9)

4 A piece of leather that protects the fingers from string wear. (6,3)

6 Straw disk behind the target face. (4)

8 Driving the tip of an arrow into the end of another arrow that's already in the target. (5,4)

10 An arrow with over-sized feathers, used in bird hunting. (3-3)

11 The end loop of a bow string. (3)

12 A group of arrows before
- being retrieved from the target and scored. (3)

13 Ascertain number of arrows, shot from established distances, in competition. A round is made up of ends. (5)

5 A sharpened steel point used in bow hunting. (9)

7 To release. (5)

9 The side of the bow nearest the archer. (5)

- 2 Slight forward movement of the arrow point before release. (8)

3 Part of the bow from the handle to the tip. (4)
