

- 4** A piece of leather that protects the fingers from string wear. (6,3)
- 6** Straw disk behind the target face. (4)
- 8** Driving the tip of an arrow into the end of another arrow that's already in the target. (5,4)
- 10** An arrow with over-sized feathers, used in bird hunting. (3-3)
- 11** The end loop of a bow string. (3)
- 12** A group of arrows before

being retrieved from the target and scored. (3)

- 13** A certain number of arrows, shot from established distances, in competition. A round is made up of ends. (5)
