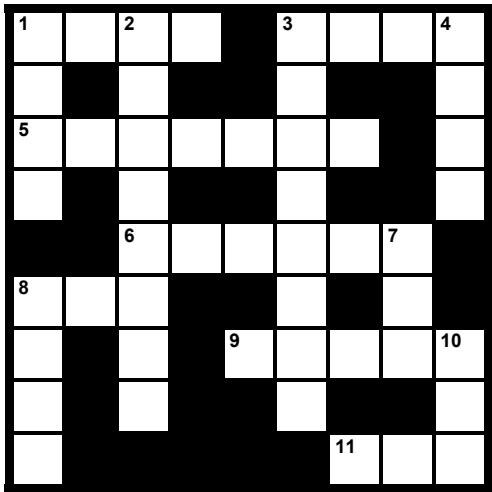

Across

- 1 Unorthodox mercilessbatting shot. (4)
- 3 A fielding positionbehind thewicketand close to the axis of the pitch. ( 4)
- 5 The gamut of fielders positioned within 30 yards radius. (7)
- 6 A batsman is declaredXXX XXXby the umpire if the fielders hit the ball at the wickets before the batsman completes his running between the wickets. (3,3)
- 8 Run scored when a ball moves away without touching batsman's bat or his body. ( 3)

- 9 A fielding position in front of the wicket on the off side. ( 5)
- 11 Nickname of Sir Donald Bradman. (3)

Down

- 1 A fielding position behind the wicket on the off side. ( 4)
- 2 A ball that turns from off to leg for a righthanded batsman. (3-5)
- 3 When the batting side is asked by the leading (by a minimum prescribed score) team captain to bat again immediately. (6,2)
- 4 Unintended contact of the ball with bat's edge, which might result into a catch at slips. (4)
- 7 Match that ends with equal score by both sides. (3)
- 8 A delivery by the bowler. ( 4)
- 10 Basic unit of scoring. (3)
