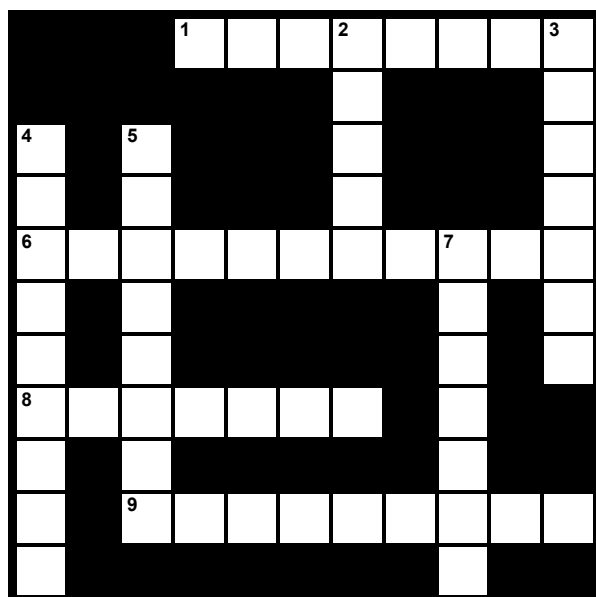

Across

- 1 A shot released at the high point of a jump. (4,4)
- 6 An offensive player's throw from a corner at the offensive end of the court, after the ball has gone over the back line after being touched by a defender other than the goalkeeper. (6,5)
- 8 A player, usually tall and a good jumper, who shoots from the backcourt. (7)
- 9 Fresh start awarded for a minor offence by the opponent. (4,5)

Down

- 2 An offensive player who plays largely around the six-metre line; also called a "line player". (5)
- 3 A throw from the side of the court to restart play after the ball has gone over the sidelines. (5-2)
- 4 When a player is sent out from the game with no replacement allowed. (9)
- 5 A throw from the centre line to a team-mate at least three metres away and behind the line, used to restart play. (5-3)
- 7 A card

signifying a referee has ejected a player from the game. (3,4)
