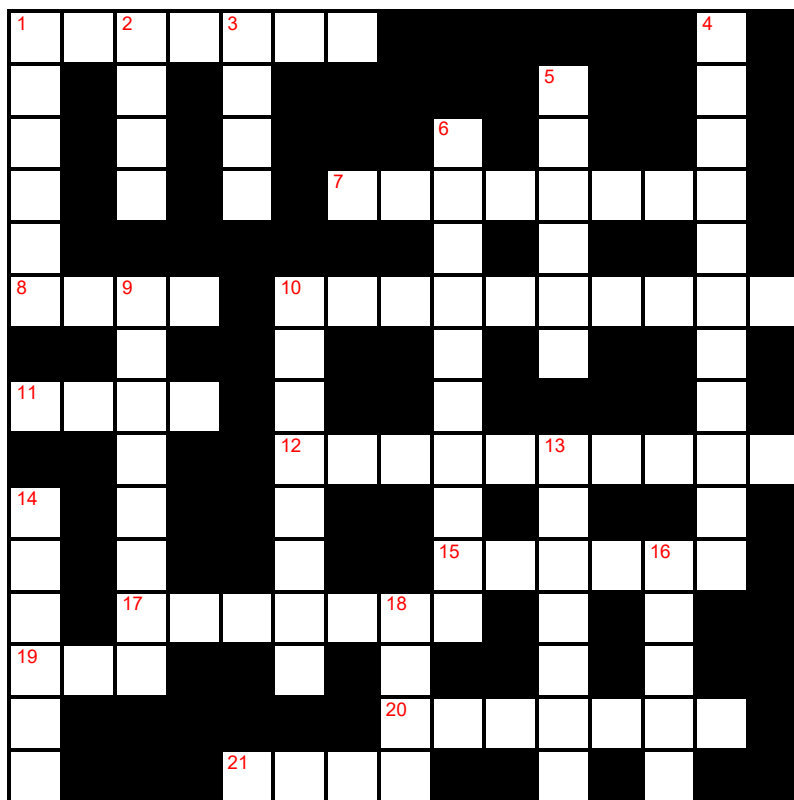

- 11 Scoring point. (4)
- 12 An area outside the playing area with a bench behind the sideboards where penalized players wait to come back. (7,3)

- 15 He guards the goal. Also called goalkeeper. (6)
- 17 A violation committed when a player's both skates cross the blue line before the puck crosses it. It leads to face-off. (7)
- 19 The goal. (3)
- 20 Penalty for hitting the opponent with knee. (7)
- 21 The successful attempt by goalie to stop a shot. (4)

- 1 List of the players in a team. (6)
- 2 Any violation of the rules attracting penalty. (4)

- 3 The iced area on which the game of hockey is played. (4)
- 4 Area between the blue lines. (7,4)
- 5 A pass preceding a successful goal attempt. (6)
- 6 Substitution of the entire forward or defensive line by other players. (4,6)
- 9 A very high speed shot. (4,4)
- 10 The act of leaving the incoming puck for another team mate following him to play. (4,4)
- 13 A player following his attacking teammate ready to receive a pass. (7)

- 14 Any of the meeting points of sideboards and endboards. (6)
- 16 A shot from behind the red center line, which crosses opponent's goal line after being touched by an opponent other than the goalie. (5)
- 18 To deceive an opponent with a fake. (4)
