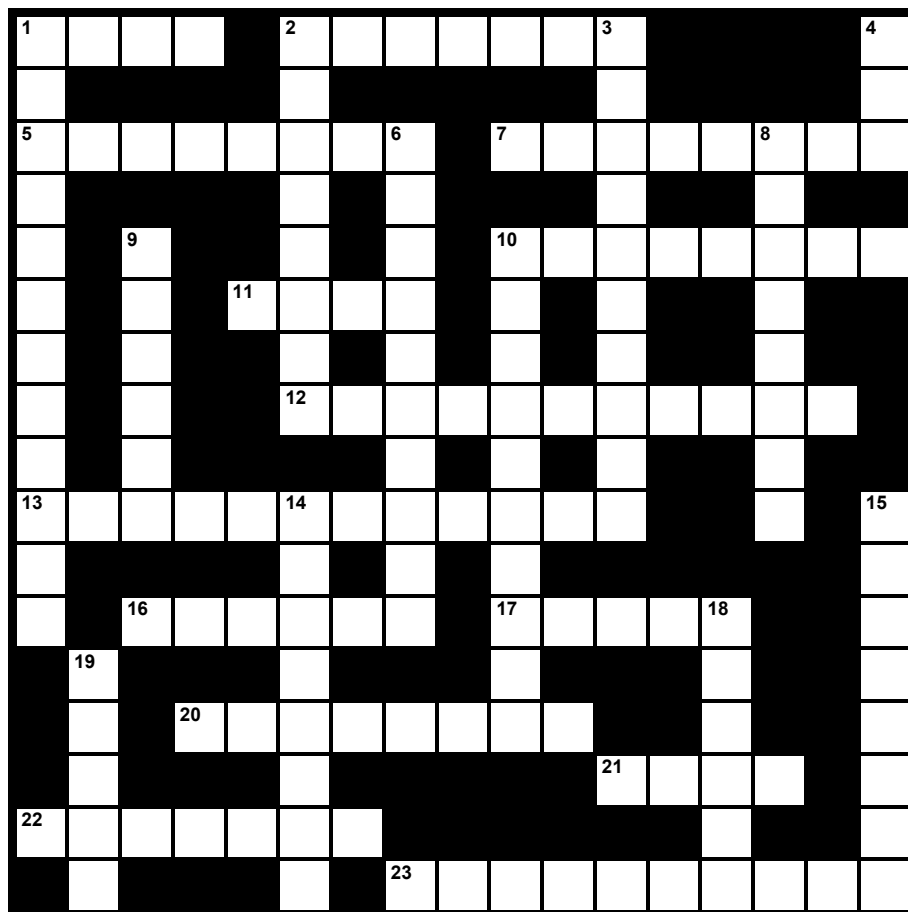

### Across

- 1 Top end of the stick. (4)
- 2 Passing of the puck. (7)
- 5 The act of leaving the incoming puck for another teammate following him to play. (4,4)
- 7 A very high speed shot. (4,4)
- 10 A shot or pass made from left side by a right-handed player. (8)
- 11 The successful attempt by goalie to stop a shot. ( 4)
- 12 A team with one or more of its players confined to penalty box. (11)

- 13 Penalty for affecting the movement of an opponent without the puck. (12)
- 16 A wooden wall surrounding the playing area of rink. (6)
- 17 A shot from behind the red center line, which crosses opponent's goal line after being touched by an opponent other than the goalie. ( 5)
- 20 The cage netted on three sides with front side open for players to score/defend. ( 4,4)
- 21 Rush by a player alone and unassisted by teammates. (4)
- 22 three 20-minute playing intervals separated by two intermissions. (7)

- 23 A player with a prime duty of preventing the opposition from scoring. (10)

### Down

- 1 A check made with hip or shoulder to disturb the balance of opposing player in control of the puck. (4,8)
- 2 A pass along the surface of ice. ( 4,4)
- 3 Semi-circular area just in front of the goalcage. (4,6)
- 4 The goal. ( 3)
- 6 The boards along the sides of playing area. (10)
- 8 Faking out the opponent through deliberate wrong sided head movements. (4,4)

- 9 A pass preceding a successful goal attempt. (6)
- 10 A minor penalty for hitting the opponent with the butt. ( 4-6)
- 14 All the three players forming the forward line. (8)
- 15 The two officials on the ice, one toward each end of the rink. (8)
- 18 He guards the goal. Also called goalkeeper. (6)
- 19 The act of staying close to an opponent to prevent him from receiving a pass. ( 5)
