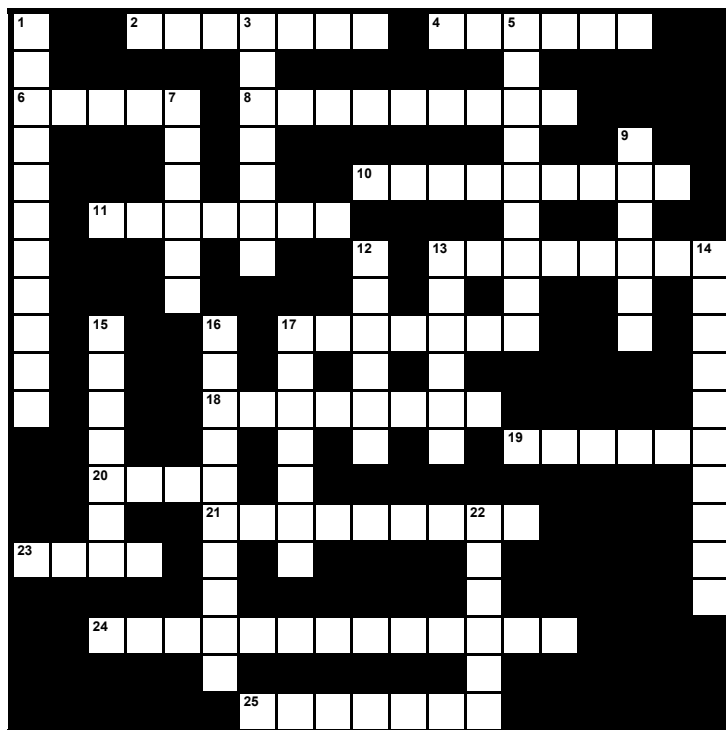

### Across

- 2 A martial art sport involving use of swords. (7)
- 4 A sport involving propelling with oars. (6)
- 6 A game for two players who move their 16 pieces according to specific rules; the object is to checkmate the opponent's king. (5)
- 8 A game played on an ice rink by two opposing teams of 6 skaters each who try to knock a flat round puck into the opponents' goal with hockey sticks. (3,6)
- 10 An athletic contest involving three different events. (9)
- 11 The sport of shooting arrows with a bow. (7)
- 13 Watersport of travelling in water without mechanical aids.. (8)

- 17 A game played on ice; curling stones (heavy stones with handles) are slid toward a target (7)
- 18 The sport involving firing of projectiles. (8)
- 19 A game played with rackets by two or four players who hit a ball back and forth over a net that divides the court. (6)
- 20 A racing sled for one or two people. (4)
- 21 A Korean martial art similar to karate. (9)
- 23 A sport adapted from jujitsu (using principles of not resisting) and similar to wrestling; developed in Japan. (4)
- 24 Skating on wheels. (6,7)
- 25 The sport of traveling on a bicycle. (7)

- 1 A game played on a handball court with short-handled rackets. (11)
- 3 A game played with a ball and bat by two teams of 11 players; teams take turns trying to score runs. (7)
- 5 The sport of hand-to-hand struggle between unarmed contestants who try to throw each other down. (9)
- 7 A football game in which two teams of 11 players try to kick or head a ball into the opponents' goal. (6)
- 9 Fighting with the fists. (6)
- 12 A traditional Japanese system of unarmed combat; sharp blows and kicks are given to pressure-sensitive points on the body of the opponent. (6)
- 13 A sport in which

participants must travel on skis. (6)

- 14 A sport that involves exercises intended to display strength and balance and agility. (10)
- 15 A long racing sled (for 2 or more people) with a steering mechanism. (7)
- 16 A game played on a court by two opposing teams of 5 players; points are scored by throwing the ball through an elevated horizontal hoop. (10)
- 17 A game in which players hit a wooden ball through a series of hoops; the winner is the first to traverse all the hoops and hit a peg. (7)
- 22 An athletic competition that involves jumping into water. (6)
