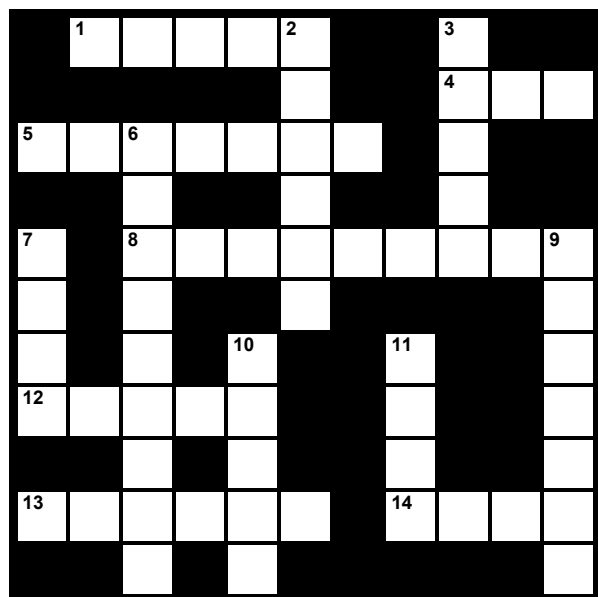

Across

- 1 The second nearest planet to the sun; visible as an early 'morning star' or an 'evening star'; rotates slowly clockwise (in the opposite direction from the normal rotation of the planets). (5)
- 4 The fifth sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about July 23 to August 22. (3)
- 5 Celestial bodies (other than comets or satellites) that

revolve around the sun in the solar system. (7)

- 8 The tenth sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about December 22 to January 19. (9)
- 12 An extreme state of adversity; the lowest point of anything. (5)
- 13 The fourth sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about June 21 to July 22. (6)
- 14 One of 12 equal areas into which the zodiac is divided. (4)

Down

- 2 A giant planet which is surrounded by three planar concentric rings of ice particles; 6th planet from the sun. (6)
- 3 The second smallest planet and the farthest known from the sun; has the most elliptical orbit of all the planets. (5)
- 6 Someone from whom you are descended (but usually more remote than a grandparent). (9)

- 7 The natural satellite of the Earth. (4)
- 9 A giant planet with a ring of ice particles; the 8th planet from the sun. (7)
- 10 The first sign of the zodiac which the sun enters at the vernal equinox; the sun is in this sign from about March 21 to April 19. (5)
- 11 The 4th planet from the sun. (4)
