

- 10 The tenth sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about December 22 to January 19. (9)
- 15 The ninth sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about November 22 to December 21. (11)
- 17 The fourth sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about June 21 to July 22. (6)

18 The cardinal number that is the sum of one and two. (5)

22 An extreme state of adversity; the lowest point of anything. (5)

24 The second sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about April 20 to May 20. (6)

25 The natural satellite of the Earth. (4)

26 Pass across (a sign or house of the zodiac) or pass across (the disk of a celestial body or the meridian of a place). (7)
