

### Across

- 1 One of 12 equal areas into which the zodiac is divided. (6)
- 5 Relating to or accompanying birth. (5)
- 7 The tenth sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about December 22 to January 19. (9)
- 10 The natural satellite of the Earth. (4)
- 11 A giant planet with a ring of ice particles; the 8th planet from the sun. (7)
- 13 Move in a direction contrary to the usual one; of stars and planets. (10)
- 15 The seventh sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about September 23 to October 22. (5)
- 17 A prediction about how something will develop or happen. (8)
- 19 The smallest planet and the nearest to the sun. (7)
- 20 The third sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about May 21 to June 20. (6)
- 22 Pass across (a sign or house of the zodiac) or pass across (the disk of a celestial body or the meridian of a place). (7)
- 24 A person considered as descended from some ancestor or race. (10)
- 27 The twelfth sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about February 19 to March 20. (6)
- 28 A giant planet which is surrounded by three planar concentric rings of ice particles; 6th planet from the sun. (6)



- 29 Celestial bodies (other than comets or satellites) that revolve around the sun in the solar system. (7)

- 2 One of 12 equal areas into which the zodiac is divided. (4)
- 3 The eighth sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about October 23 to November 21. (7)
- 4 The largest planet and the 5th from the sun; has many satellites. (7)
- 6 The fifth sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about July 23 to August 22. (3)
- 7 The fourth sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about June 21 to July 22. (6)
- 8 Apparent meeting or passing of two or more celestial bodies in the same degree of the zodiac. (11)
- 9 An extreme state of adversity; the lowest point of anything. (5)
- 12 The second smallest planet and the farthest known from the sun; has the most elliptical orbit of all the planets. (5)
- 14 An annual publication containing tables that give the positions of the celestial bodies throughout the year. (9)
- 16 A blemish on the skin formed before birth. (9)
- 18 The aspect or position of two planets when distant from each other sixty degrees, or two signs. (7)
- 21 The second nearest planet to the sun; visible as an early 'morning star' or an 'evening star'; rotates slowly clockwise (in the opposite direction from the normal rotation of the planets). (5)
- 22 The second sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about April 20 to May 20. (6)
- 23 The expression on a person's face. (7)
- 25 The cardinal number that is the sum of one and two. (5)
- 26 The 4th planet from the sun. (4)
