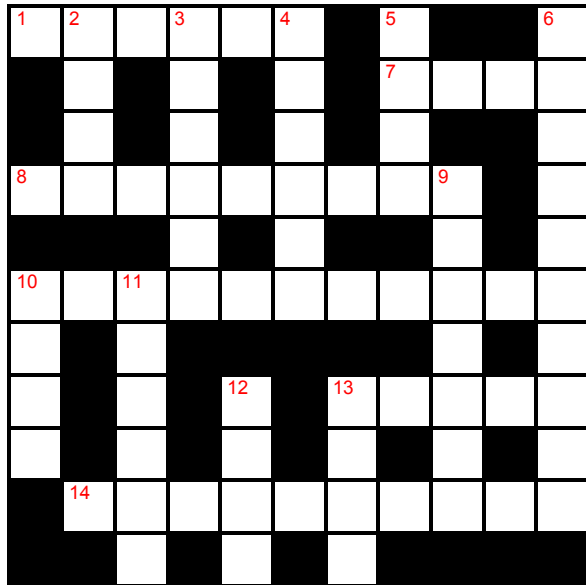

- 4 Jaspinder ____ got real fame after her duet 'Pyar To Hona Hi Tha' with Remo Fernandes. (6)
- 5 First name of India's leading virtuoso of the tabla and one of the world's greatest and most influential percussionists. Micky Hart referred him as "Einstein of Rhythm". (4)
- 6 The most popular singer of Agra Gharana; became a court musician in Jaipur. (6,4)
- 9 Last name of the top class playback singer in the Ghazal family of the Indian film music. (7)
- 10 Narayan Rao ____, born in Kolhapur, was an expert high pitch singer. (4)
- 11 Last name of the greatest of the great singers of twentieth century; also acted in films. (6)
- 12 ____ Narayan's songs in 'Qayamat Se Qayamat Tak' made him real star with no further looking back. (4)
- 13 Raga "____ Sarang" sung or played by top Indian musicians. (4)
