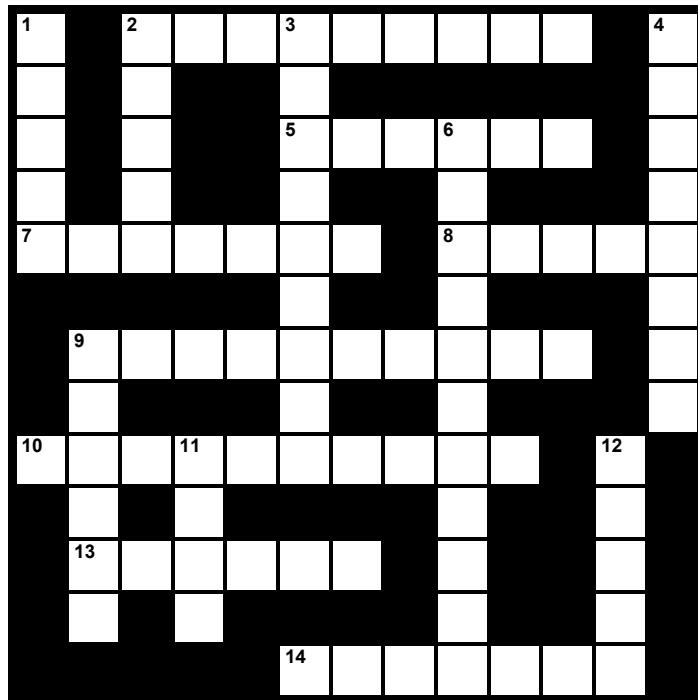

- 2 Loss of the ability to move a body part. (9)
- 5 Rickettsial disease transmitted by body lice and characterized by skin rash and high fever. (6)
- 7 An acute intestinal infection caused by ingestion of contaminated water or food. (7)
- 8 A condition marked by uncontrollable tremor. (5)
- 9 Acute contagious infection marked by constriction of air passages causing difficulty in breathing. (10)
- 10 Crowding of blood or other fluid in a body part. (10)
- 13 Weakness caused by deficiency of ascorbic acid (vitamin C). (6)
- 14 An infective disease caused by sporozoan parasites that are transmitted through the bite of an infected Anopheles mosquito; marked by paroxysms of chills and fever. (7)
