

- 2 Relating to the nose. (5)
- 5 Front part of the human leg between the knee and the ankle. (4)
- 7 Digit of human foot. (3)
- 8 Any bulge or swelling of an anatomical structure or part. (4)
- 10 A tube-like canal that functions to empty the bladder of urine. (7)

13 The body is spindle-shaped and only slightly compressed \_\_\_\_\_. (9)

15 That's what 'E' in 'ENT' stands for. (3)

16 Part of the alimentary canal between the stomach and the anus. (3)

- 1 Used for biting and chewing or for attack and defence. (5)
- 2 That's what 'N' in 'ENT' stands for. (4)

3 A watertight container for your body. (4)

4 Any of the terminal members of the hand. (6)

6 Near the kidneys. (7)

9 End of leg. (4)

10 A hollow muscular organ in the pelvic cavity of females; contains the developing fetus. (6)

11 Superior limb. (3)

12 A structure in a hollow organ (like the heart)

with a flap to insure one-way flow of fluid through it. (5)

14 Includes the upper and lower thigh and shank. (3)
