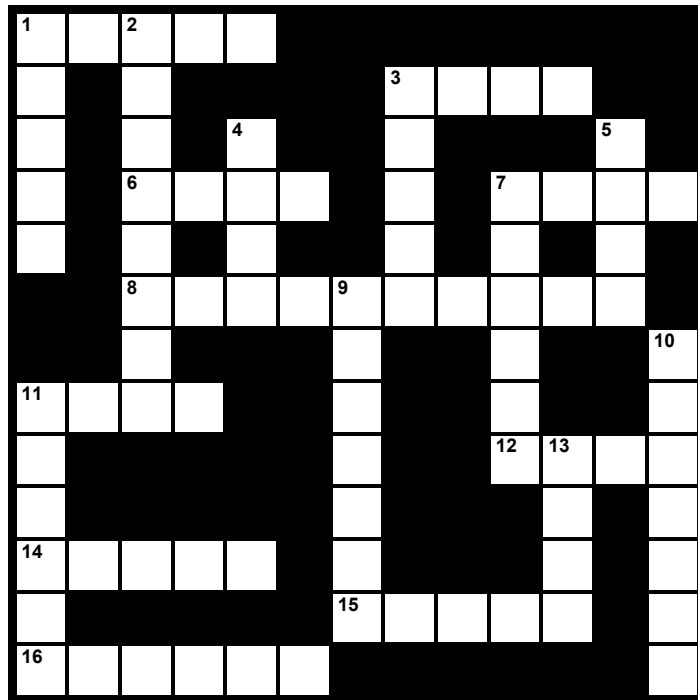

- 7 Foreparts of feet. (4)
- 8 The part of the alimentary canal between the stomach and the anus. (10)
- 11 Olfactory organ. (4)
- 12 The sense organs for hearing and equilibrium. (4)
- 14 Blood vessels that carry blood from the capillaries toward the heart. (5)
- 15 Extremities of the superior limbs. (5)
- 16 A large dark-red oval organ on the left side of the body between the stomach and the diaphragm; produces cells involved in immune responses. (6)
- 2 Blood vessels that carry blood from the heart to the body. (8)
- 3 The locus of feelings and intuitions. (5)
- 4 Support the whole body weight. (4)
- 5 The parts between the knees and ankles. (4)
- 7 A mobile mass of muscular tissue covered with mucous membrane and located in the oral cavity. (6)
- 9 An enlarged and muscular saclike organ of the alimentary canal. (7)
- 10 Contractile organs of the body. (7)
- 11 Any bundle of nerve fibers running to various organs and tissues of the body. (6)
- 13 Superior limbs between the shoulder and the elbow. (4)
