

- 1 Small hole in teeth caused by tooth decay (6)
- 5 End of leg (4)
- 7 Bony skeleton of the head of vertebrates (5)
- 8 The muscle tissue of the heart (7,6)
- 12 A joint between the distal end of the radius and the proximal row of carpal bones (5,5)
- 15 Digit of human foot (3)
- 17 Near the kidneys (7)
- 18 Of or relating to the kidneys (5)
- 19 _____ bud: An oval sensory end organ on the surface of the tongue (5)
- 22 Fleshy folds of tissue that surround the mouth (4)
- 25 Bone in the ankle that articulates with the leg bones to form the ankle joint (9)
- 27 Sense organ for hearing (3)
- 28 Any bulge or swelling of an anatomical structure or part (4)
- 29 Part of the alimentary canal between the stomach and the anus (3)
- 30 organ of sight (3)

- 2 A whole superior limb, though technically only its part (3)
- 3 Ductless gland in base of neck (7)
- 4 Being of delicate or slender build (4)
- 6 Of, like or pertaining to the ear (4)
- 7 Arises from the sacral plexus and passes about halfway down the thigh where it divides into the common peroneal and tibial nerves (7,5)
- 8 Also called Bulbourethral gland (7,5)
- 9 Relating to or near the ulna (5)
- 10 A flap of cartilage that covers the windpipe while swallowing (10)
- 11 A bodily passage conveying a secretion (4)
- 13 Administered by mouth (4)
- 14 Excretory opening at the end of the alimentary canal (4)
- 16 A special variety of domesticated animals within a species (5)
- 20 Hinge joint between the forearm and upper arm (5)
- 21 A large dark-red oval organ on the left side of the body in the abdomen (6)
- 23 Front part of the human leg between the knee and the ankle (4)
- 24 Any small opening in the skin (4)
- 26 Limb including the upper and lower thigh and shank (3)
