

- 1 Domestic swine. (4)
- 3 Small songbirds with short stout bills adapted for crushing seeds. (7)
- 5 Venomous Old World snakes characterized by hollow venom-conducting fangs in the upper jaw. (6)
- 7 Domestic swine. (4)
- 10 Stout-bodied short-legged omnivorous animals. (5)
- 11 Any of numerous marine mammals that come on shore to breed; chiefly of cold regions. (5)
- 12 Woolly usually horned ruminant mammals related to the goat. (5)
- 14 Social insects living in organized colonies. (4)

16 Domesticated bovine animals as a group regardless of sex or age. (4)

17 Usually brightly colored zygodactyl tropical birds with short hooked beaks and the ability to mimic sounds. (7)

18 Small wild or domesticated web-footed broad-billed swimming birds usually having a depressed body and short legs. (5)

20 Mostly cold-blooded aquatic vertebrates usually having scales and breathing through gills. (4)

22 Invertebrates having a soft unsegmented body usually enclosed in a shell. (8)

23 Marine mollusks having a rough irregular shell; found on the sea bed mostly

in coastal waters. (7)

24 Any of various burrowing animals of the family Leporidae having long ears and short tails; some domesticated and raised for pets or food. (7)

Down

- 1 Any of various breeds of small gentle horses usually less than five feet high at the shoulder. (6)
- 2 Hairy-bodied insects including social and solitary species. (4)
- 4 Solid-hoofed herbivorous quadrupeds domesticated since prehistoric times. (6)
- 6 Large long-tailed gallinaceous birds native to the Old World but introduced elsewhere. (9)
- 8 Web-footed long-necked typically
- 9 Five-toed pachyderms. (9)
- 11 Small dull-coloured singing birds feeding on seeds or insects. (8)
- 13 Any of various tailless stout-bodied amphibians with long hind limbs for leaping; semiaquatic and terrestrial species. (5)
- 15 Stately heavy-bodied aquatic birds with very long neck and usually white plumage as adult. (5)
- 19 Black birds having a raucous call. (5)
- 21 Adult female chickens. (4)
- gregarious migratory aquatic birds usually larger and less aquatic than ducks. (5)
