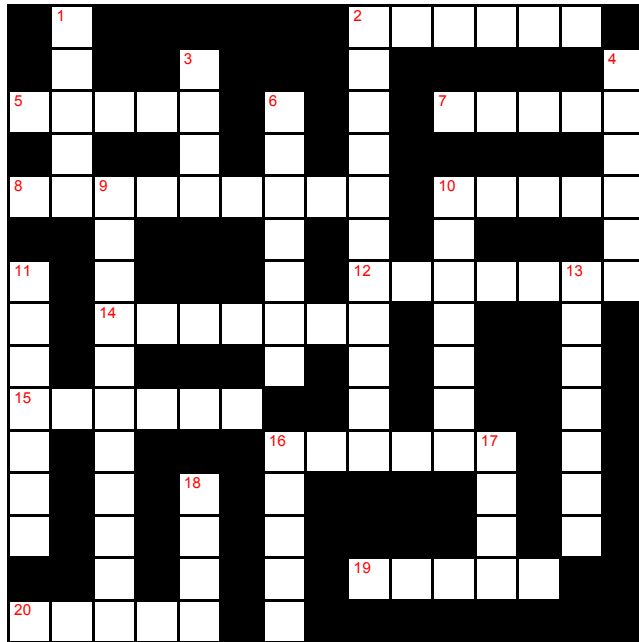

Across

- 2 A giant planet which is surrounded by three planar concentric rings of ice particles; 6th planet from the sun. (6)
- 5 Sixth sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about August 23 to September 22. (5)
- 7 Seventh sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about September 23 to October 22. (5)
- 8 Someone from whom you are descended (usually more remote than a grandparent). (9)
- 10 An extreme state of adversity; the lowest point of anything. (5)
- 12 The expression on a person's face. (7)
- 14 The largest planet and the 5th from the sun; has many satellites. (7)
- 15 The fourth sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this

sign from about June 21 to July 22. (6)

- 16 The twelfth sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about February 19 to March 20. (6)
- 19 A group of three. (5)
- 20 Second nearest planet to the sun; visible as an early 'morning star' or an 'evening star'; rotates slowly clockwise (in the opposite direction from the normal rotation of the planets). (5)

Down

- 1 First sign of zodiac which the sun enters at vernal equinox; sun is in this sign from about March 21 to April 19. (5)
- 2 Ninth sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about November 22 to December 21. (11)

- 3 The natural satellite of the Earth. (4)
- 4 Second sign of the zodiac; the sun is in this sign from about April 20 to May 20. (6)
- 6 Celestial bodies (other than comets or satellites) that revolve around the sun in the solar system. (7)
- 9 Apparent meeting or passing of two or more celestial bodies in the same degree of the zodiac. (11)
- 10 A giant planet with a ring of ice particles; the 8th planet from the sun. (7)
- 11 The smallest planet and the nearest to the sun. (7)
- 13 Pass across (a sign or house of the zodiac). (7)
- 16 The second smallest planet and the farthest known from the sun; has the most elliptical orbit of all the planets. (5)

17 One of 12 equal areas into which the zodiac is divided. (4)

18 The 4th planet from the sun. (4)
