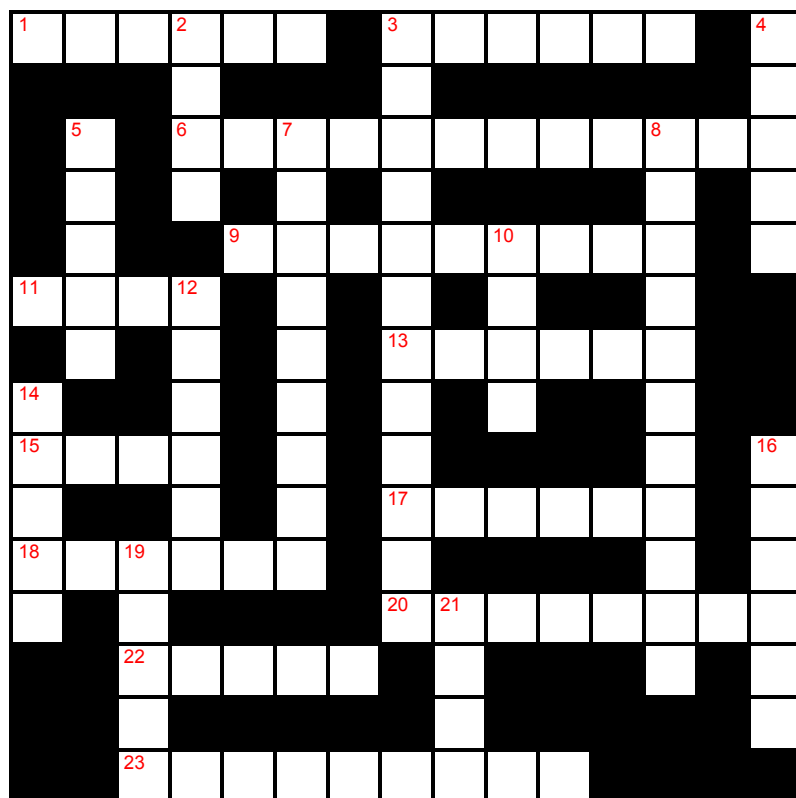

- 1 The inner margin of a leaf near the spine of a book. (6)
- 3 Becoming less intense in colour when exposed to light. (6)
- 6 The first section of and about a book. (12)
- 9 Describes a book with a picture on the cover. (9)
- 11 Flexible binding in suede or imitation leather. (4)
- 13 A group of volumes with a common theme issued in succession by a single publisher. (6)
- 15 Make editorial changes (in a text). (4)
- 17 Compilation of mistakes or errors. (6)

- 18 A thin, protective sheet laid over an illustration. (6)
- 20 Something that disappears quickly, like manifestos, broadsides, programs, , etc. (8)
- 22 An alphabetical listing of names or topics mentioned in the book, with their page numbers. (5)
- 23 Sheets of paper pasted onto the inner covers, joining the book block to the covers. (3,6)

Down

- 2 The lower margin of a leaf, cover or endpaper. (4)

- 3 Front illustration facing the title page of a book. (12)
- 4 The joint (either outer or inner) of the binding of a book - the part that bends when the book is opened. (5)
- 5 A sheet of any written or printed material (especially in a manuscript or book). (5)
- 7 Decorative material on the lower part of a page at the end of a chapter or a poem. (9)
- 8 Decorated with pictures or other graphical material to portray or clarify the text. (11)
- 10 Implies the books is extremely scarce. (4)
- 12 Whole-page illustrations

printed separately from the text. (6)

- 14 The front side of a leaf in a bound book; in other words, the right-hand page of an opened book. Also called the Obverse. (5)
- 16 The size of a book whose pages are made by folding a sheet of paper three times to form eight leaves. (6)
- 19 The book's backbone. (5)
- 21 One side of a leaf. (4)
