

- 18 The size of a book whose pages are made by folding a sheet of paper twice to form four leaves (6)
- 20 Any book with a paper cover (9)
- 21 Paper-covered boards with the spine bound in cloth (4-5)
- 22 A trial impression made to check for errors (5)
- 25 Implies the books is extremely scarce (4)
- 27 The upper margin of a leaf, cover or endpaper (4)

- 3 A group of volumes with a common theme issued in succession by a single publisher (6)

- 5 A Latin term meaning "let it stand" which instructs a printer or typesetter to ignore an alteration (4)
- 7 Whole-page illustrations printed separately from the text (6)
- 8 An impression produced by pressure or printing (7)
- 12 Written entirely in one's own hand (9)
- 14 The size of a book whose pages are made by folding a sheet of paper three times to form eight leaves (6)
- 15 A lease from one lessee to another (6)
- 16 A detailed and documented treatise on a particular subject (9)
- 17 Advertising ____ - the content and context of a message contained in an advertisement (4)
- 19 The front side of a leaf in a bound book; in other words, the right-hand page of an opened book. Also called the Obverse (5)
- 23 Becoming less intense in colour when exposed to light (6)
- 24 The exterior junction of the covers and spine of a book (5)
- 26 Unit of geological time that is a subdivision of a period and is itself divided into ages (5)
