

 12 Swara exercises in double notes. (Java is Adrian) (5,7)
 15 A series of notes in the ascending order of pitch: s r g m p d n s. (Mara Hona) (8)

16 Moderate speed or tempo. (A Hammaka Lady) (8,4)
 20 A complete tala or time-measure. (Havana Mart) (10)
 21 The sixth of the seven principal talas; consists of two laghus and two drutums. (Tata Lata) (4,4)
 22 The smallest audible sound; quarter-tone, microtone, enharmonic note or interval. (I Rust) (5)

 2 One of six angas used in reckoning musical time; duration eight aksharakalas. (U Rug) (4)
 4 Second stage of speed. (Dak via Italy) (7,4)
 6 The parts of a tala. (Gana) (4)
 8 Sixth note of the scale. (I had a Vat) (8)
 9 Variation on a musical theme. (Against) (7)
 10 A series of notes in the descending order of pitch: s n d p m g r s. (Roam Havana) (10)

11 One of the tala dasa pranas; musical time; tempo; rhythm; speed. (A Lay) (4)
 13 One of the Suladi Sapta Talas and last in the rank, comprising only one laghu as its anga. (At a Lake) (3,4)
 14 Words of a musical composition. (Thy Asia) (7)
 17 Exposition of a raga. (Apala) (5)
 18 One of the six angas comprising a beat and a variable number of fingercounts according to its jati. (Laugh) (5)
 19 One of the tala dasa pranas. (Taji) (4)
