

- 3 A thin coat of water-base paint. (4)
- 5 Refers to pigments that are liable to fade over time and exposure to light. (8)
- 8 A human or animal form. (6)
- 10 A monochrome picture made by

using several different shades of the same colour. (11)

- 11 A class of art (or artistic endeavor) having a characteristic form or technique. (5)
- 12 A genre depicting everyday life. (5,8)
- 13 Board that provides a flat surface on which artists mix paints and the range of color used. (7)

- 2 Arrangement of elements of form and colour within an artwork. (11)
- 4 The quality of a colour as determined by its dominant wavelength. (3)
- 6 A watercolor executed with opaque watercolours mixed with gum. (7)
- 7 Shaping by using blocks. (8)
- 8 The metal
- 9 A point of intense light, such as a sparkle of an eye. (9)
- 11 A transparent layer of color laid over or under another colour. (5)
- 12 A cylinder that surrounds and encloses the hairs on a brush. (7)
