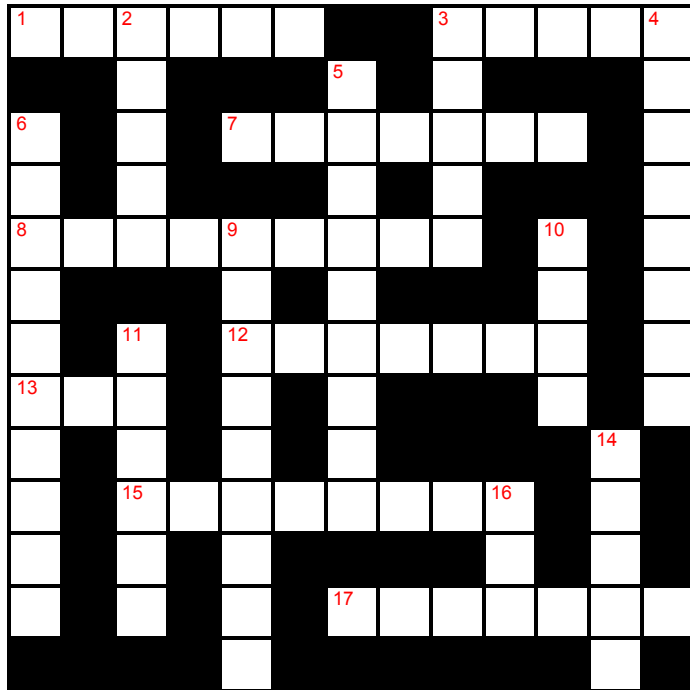

- 3 A class of art (or artistic endeavor) having a characteristic form or technique (5)
- 7 A paste-up made by sticking together pieces of paper or photographs (7)
- 8 Painting depicting an expanse of natural scenery (9)
- 12 A humorous or satirical drawing (7)

- 13 The quality of a colour as determined by its dominant wavelength (3)

- 15 A black liquid ink used for printing or writing or drawing (5,3)

- 17 Paint prepared from pigments and a synthetic plastic binder (7)

- 2 Basic structure of a paper surface as in fine, medium and rough (5)

- 3 A transparent layer of colour laid over or under another colour (5)

- 4 A refined quality of gracefulness and good taste (8)

- 5 A method in which the painting is completed with the first application of paints to the entire area, instead of being built up by layering (4,5)

- 6 Colour with many colours (10)

- 9 Colours obtained by mixing two primary colours such as yellow and blue creating green (9)
