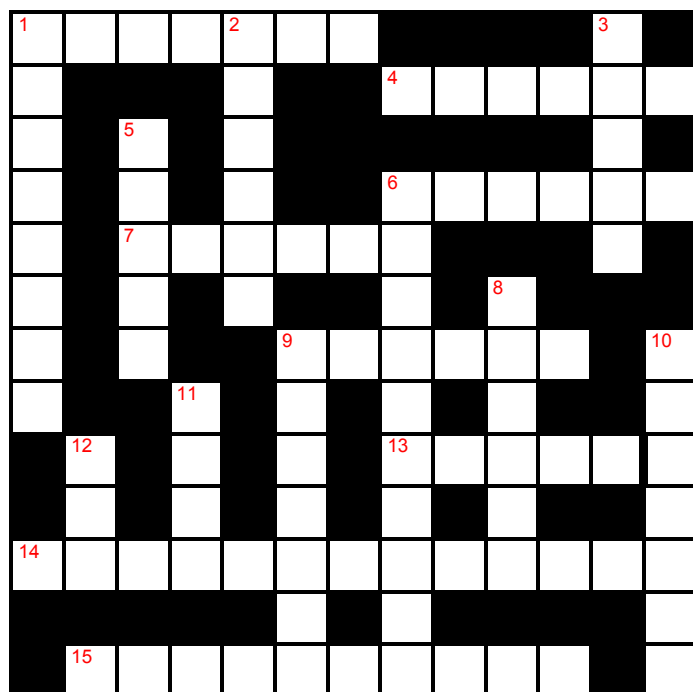

## Across

- 1 A small constellation in the northern hemisphere between Cygnus and Aquila and crossed by the Milky Way (7)
- 4 A constellation in the northern hemisphere near Ursa Major (6)
- 6 A constellation in the northern hemisphere between Pegasus and Draco in the Milky Way; contains a black hole (6)
- 7 A constellation in the Milky Way near Cygnus; contains the star Altair (6)
- 9 A large faint zodiacal constellation; between Aquarius and Aries (6)
- 13 A constellation on the

equator east of Taurus; contains Betelgeuse and Rigel (5)

- 14 A constellation in the northern hemisphere between Ursa Major and Bootes; contains a cluster of some 10,000 galaxies (4,9)

- 15 A constellation southeast of Orion; contains Sirius (5,5)

## Down

- 1 A large zodiacal constellation between Libra and Sagittarius (8)
- 2 A zodiacal constellation in the northern hemisphere near Orion; between Aries and Gemini (6)
- 3 A constellation in the

southern hemisphere near Orion and Columba (5)

- 5 A faint constellation twisting around the north celestial pole and lying between Ursa Major and Cepheus (5)

- 6 A W-shaped constellation in the northern hemisphere near Polaris (10)

- 8 A zodiacal constellation in the northern hemisphere between Taurus and Cancer on the ecliptic (6)

- 9 A conspicuous constellation in the northern hemisphere; between Auriga and Cassiopeia and crossed by the Milky

Way (7)

- 10 A constellation in the northern hemisphere near Andromeda and Pisces (7)

- 11 A sails-shaped constellation in the southern hemisphere near Carina (4)

- 12 A zodiacal constellation in northern hemisphere between Cancer and Virgo (3)
