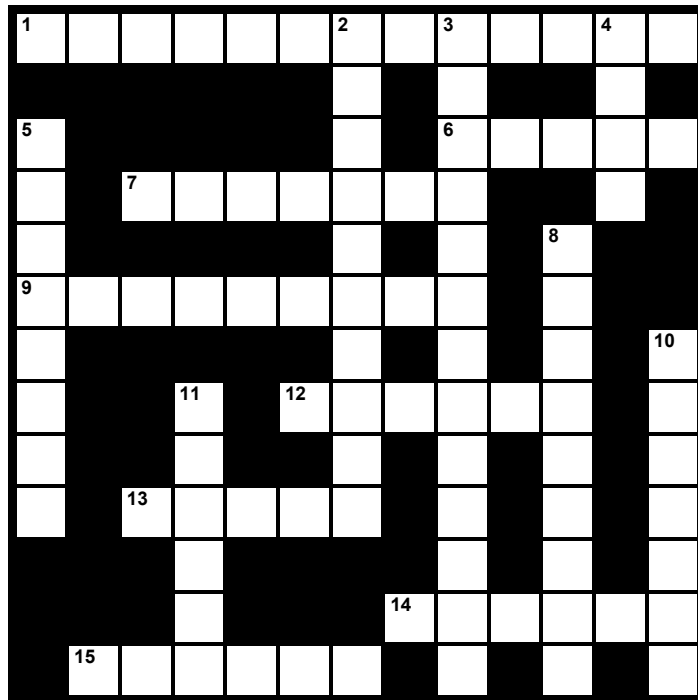

- 9** Scraping of gums to remove bacteria. (9)
- 12** Towards the back of the mouth. (6)
- 13** Part of your tooth above your gum. (5)
- 14** Toward the inside of the cheek. (6)

- 15** Cavities due to tooth decay. (6)

- 2** Using a solution to wash out your mouth and to flush debris. (10)
- 3** A general term for the dental chairs, lights and equipment used by your dentist or orthodontist. (13)
