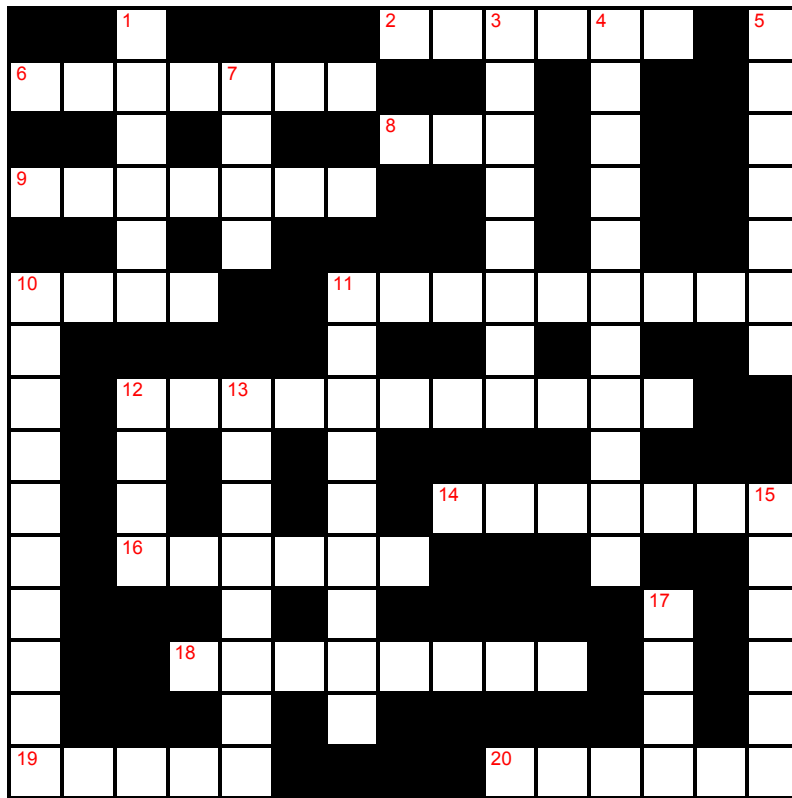

## Across

- 2 Toward the inside of the cheek (6)
- 6 The arrangement of the bones in your skeleton (7)
- 8 The tissue (covered by mucous membrane) of the jaws that surrounds the bases of the teeth (3)
- 9 The first set of teeth which come in; also called baby teeth (7)
- 10 Bottom tip of the root of your tooth (4)
- 11 Arrangement of the teeth (9)
- 12 The very inner part of your tooth containing nerve cells and blood vessels (4,7)
- 14 The biting edge of your centrals and laterals (7)
- 16 Thin sticky film of bacteria which grows on your teeth; the main cause of tooth decay and gum disease (6)
- 18 A tooth having two cusps or points; located between the incisors and the molars (8)
- 19 Part of your tooth above your gum (5)
- 20 Towards the back of the mouth (6)

- 1 Another name for the cuspids (6)
- 3 A specialized bony substance covering the root of a tooth (8)
- 4 A drug that causes temporary loss of bodily sensations (11)
- 5 A replacement for one of your missing teeth (7)
- 7 Pertaining to the mouth (4)
- 10 A chemical agent which can be applied to living tissues to destroy germs (10)
- 11 Baby teeth that are shed during growth period (9)
- 12 The soft inner structure of a tooth, consisting of nerve and blood vessels (4)
- 13 A process where an archwire is attached to the brackets on your teeth (8)
- 15 On or relating to the tooth surface next to your lips (6)
- 17 The part of your tooth under your gums (4)
