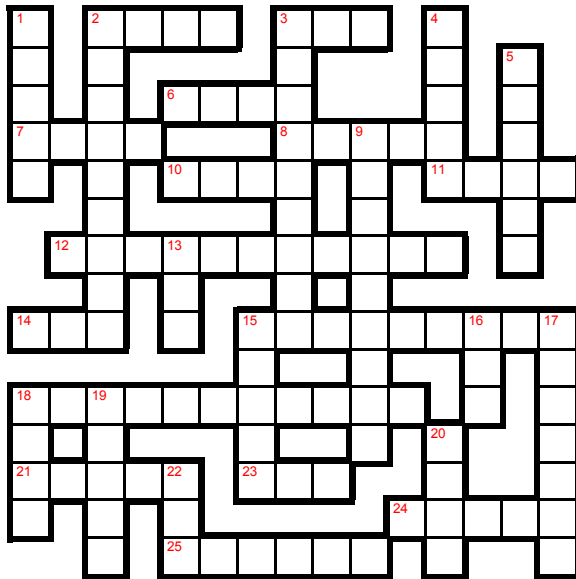

- 2 Fermented juice (of grapes especially). (4)
- 3 A beverage made by steeping tea leaves in water. (3)
- 6 An anise-flavoured brandy made in Turkey and the Balkans from grapes, plums, or grain. (4)
- 7 Sparkling white wine from northwestern Italy. (4)
- 8 Wine and hot water with sugar and lemon juice and nutmeg. (5)
- 10 ____ & Chandon is the largest brand and manufacturer of champagne. (4)
- 11 Japanese alcoholic beverage made from fermented rice; usually served hot. (4)
- 12 Wines made at the premier wine-producing village of Germany's RHEINHESSE region full of large vineyards. (11)

- 14 Whiskey distilled from rye or rye and malt. (3)
- 15 A drink taken at sundown. (3,6)
- 18 Amber-green muscadine grape of southeastern USA. (11)
- 21 A beverage made from cocoa powder and milk and sugar; usually drunk hot. (5)
- 23 An establishment offering everything from afternoon tea to a late-night drinks and snacks. (3)
- 24 An island (part of Campania) in the Bay of Naples in southern Italy; a tourist attraction noted for beautiful scenery and wines and wine glasses. (5)
- 25 A punch made of sweetened milk or cream mixed with eggs and usually alcoholic liquor. (3-3)

- 1 Variety of wine grape originally grown in Hungary. (5)
- 2 Pale yellowish wine made from white grapes or red grapes with skins removed before fermentation. (5,4)
- 3 A colourless orange-flavoured liqueur, named after the ____ family, liqueur producers based in Angers, France. (9)
- 4 An alcoholic drink similar to beer, made in Russia from rye or barley or from stale bread. (5)
- 5 A weak fermented and often effervescent beverage made from juice of pears. (6)
- 9 Thin syrup made from pomegranate juice; used in mixed drinks. (9)
- 13 An alcoholic liquor made from sugar cane or molasses. (3)
- 15 A drink made with fruit juice, sugar, spices, and rum or other alcohol. (5)
- 16 Drink containing egg and cream. (3)
- 17 Sweet liqueur made from wine and brandy flavoured with plum or peach or apricot kernels and bitter almonds. (7)
- 18 Any of various light dry strong white wine from Spain and Canary Islands (including sherry). (4)
- 19 To remove a cap or cover from. (5)
- 20 Any of various strong liquors distilled from the fermented sap of toddy palms or from fermented molasses. (4)
- 22 A general name for beer made with a top fermenting yeast. (3)
